

SAFETY SUPPLEMENT

ATTENTION INSTALLERS/OPERATORS FOR YOUR PROTECTION:

- 1. Read and understand the Component Manufacturer's Operating Manual accompanying this equipment before performing any work.

- 4. Inlet and Outlet piping must always be permanently fastened to mating system components.
- 5. All guarding, including but not limited to, belt and coupling guards, must be installed before start up and remain in place during operation.
- 6. Always follow LOCKOUT-TAGOUT procedure before performing any work.
- 7. Consult your plant safety director, system designer, installation manager or the Meyer factory if you have any questions regarding the proper installation, operation and maintenance of this equipment.

BLOWER PACKAGE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

<u>↑ DANGER</u> Failure to observe these notices will result in serious injury or death.

- Do not use the discharge air from this unit for breathing. It is not suitable for human consumption.
- Lockout/Tagout power before working on any controls. Electrical shock can be fatal.
- Blower is not to be used where non-sparking equipment is specified.

MARNING Failure to observe these notices could result in serious injury or death.

- Lockout/Tagout power before performing servicing. Machine may start automatically. Equipment in idle mode does not mean it is offline.
- Do not operate without belt/coupling guards in place. Replace/install guards prior to start up.
- Do not loosen or remove the oil fill plug, drain plugs, or covers, etc. in the oil system until the unit is shut down and the power is locked and tagged out.
- Do not operate with open inlet or outlet port. Be sure that inlet and outlet port piping is properly installed prior to operation.
- Blower and blower discharge piping may be extremely hot and could cause skin burns on contact.

NOTICE Failure to observe these notices could result in damage to the equipment.

- Do not exceed specified vacuum or pressure limitations.
- Do not operate above or below recommended blower speed range.
- Do not restrict inlet port on pressure application or discharge port on vacuum application.
